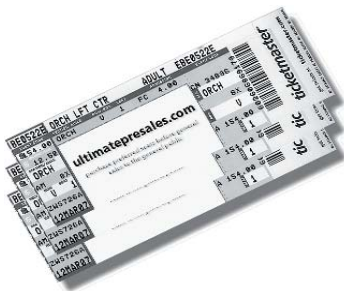
Garth Brooks to open the Sprint center in Kansas City November 14th - Chicago stop likely, not definite
